

How to Establish a Named Scholarship

Establishing a named fund is a wonderful memorial for a loved one or a great way to bring recognition to your firm's support of the University. To initialize a named fund, you must begin with a minimum pledge of \$30,000 and an initial payment of \$5,000, with payments of \$5,000 per year over a five-year period. If requested, we will announce the creation of the new fund and solicit individual contributions through fund promotional materials, publications and / or direct mail. Although \$30,000 is the minimum amount to establish a named fund, you can contribute any amount of additional funds at any time. There is no limit to how large a name fund can be – a larger endowment will produce a greater number of scholarships.

While scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$2,500, this figure may increase or decrease due to fluctuations in interest rates, student credentials, and student needs. The first scholarship will be awarded at the end of the first full year interest income reaches the scholarship level. The selection of the award recipient is chosen by the College of Engineering Scholarship Selection Committee based on the eligibility guidelines and criteria.

Named scholarships are tracked separately but combined with all other funds in the endowment for investment purposes. At the end of the five-year donation period, if contributions have not reached the \$30,000 pledge, all donations received will be transferred to the general scholarship fund.

Eligibility

Incoming Freshmen Must:

- Declare a major in engineering
- Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have a minimum ACT score of 21 or SAT score of 990
- Have a 7 semester high school transcript
Have 2 letters of recommendation

Upperclassmen Must:

- Be enrolled full-time in an engineering program
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Be in good standing at the University

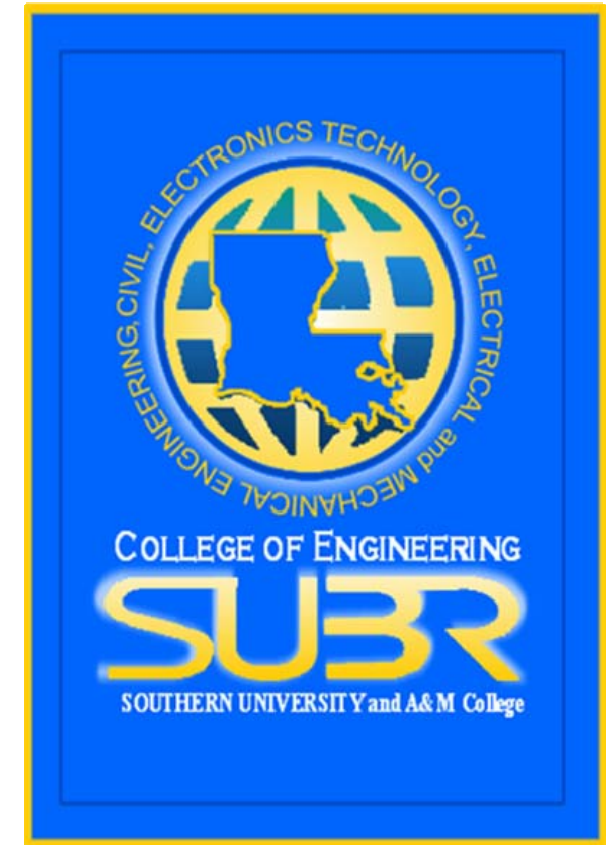
Transfer Students Must:

- Be enrolled full-time in an engineering program at the University for at least one semester
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Be in good standing at the University

SUSF is approved by I.R.S. to operate as a 501 (c) 3 corporation. Contributions or gifts to the College of Engineering Scholarship Endowment Fund are tax deductible as charitable contributions.

Scholarships in specific amounts and numbers, determined by the College of Engineering Scholarship Committee, are awarded annually according to the eligibility guidelines set by the college.
