<b>Fee</b>	<b>Charge Per Semester</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Other General</b>	\$102.00	Approved fees implemented by governing board of the University. The fees are collected for other miscellaneous activities for the University. The fees are used in the general operating budget.
<b>Academic Excellence</b>	\$120.00	The proceeds of this fee are used to enhance instructional programs. It cannot exceed \$10.00 per credit hour or \$120.00 per academic session and is waived in cases of financial hardship. It is not covered by TOPS.
<b>Operational Fee</b>	\$62.00	This fee is used for the enhancement of instructional programs. It cannot exceed 4.0% of an institution's total tuition and fees for the fall 2004 semester. It is waived for cases of financial hardship and is not covered by TOPS.
<b>Academic Enhancement</b>	\$25.00	The fee is designed to support academic programs and may be used at the University's discretion (but may not be used for faculty/staff salaries or travel). Funds may be used for instructional library books or equipment, student laboratory equipment, student computer laboratory equipment, or any expenses specifically.
<b>Building Use—Act 619</b>	\$10.00	This fee is used to finance bonds issued to construct, acquire, extend, repair, or improve any academic facilities suitable for use as a classroom, laboratory, gymnasium, library, student infirmary and related facilities. It currently serves as a de facto maintenance fee.
<b>Building Use—Act 426</b>	\$38.00	The proceeds of this fee are used to construct, acquire, repair, maintain, operate, or improve facilities and physical infrastructure. It cannot exceed \$48.00 per semester, and must be waivable in cases of financial hardship.
<b>Technology Fee</b>	\$60.00	The proceeds of this fee are used to implement, replace, improve, and expand technologies to benefit student life and learning in accordance with a written plan. It is (dis)established by a student vote. It cannot exceed \$5.00 per credit hour or \$100.00 per semester, and no one is exempted from payment.
<b>Energy Surcharge</b>	\$48.00	This fee is charged to student to cover increased costs of utilities. The amount of this surcharge is directly related to these specific costs and will be periodically adjusted up or down to reflect future increases or decreases in these outlays.

<b>Fee</b>	<b>Charge Per Semester</b>	<b>Description</b>
<b>Athletic Facilities Improvement</b>	\$25.00	This fee is used to improve academic facilities.
<b>Athletic Facility</b>	\$4.00	This fee is used to support college athletic facilities.
<b>Athletic</b>	\$245.00	This fee covers the cost of all athletic related activities and allows students to attend the events free of charge.

<b>Breakage</b>	\$1.50	\$1.50 per semester for full-time students only. This fee is to cover any damage to classrooms. This fee is not covered by TOPS.
<b>Recreation</b>	\$3.00	This fee supports university recreation.
<b>Restricted Facilities</b>	\$10.00	The fees are collected for Athletic activities at the University. The funds are used in the Athletics Budget.
<b>University Support</b>	\$835.00	This fee covers the increased operational costs incurred with maintaining equipment and student support services. This fee is not covered by TOPS.
<b>Access Fee tom E-Book Courses and Material</b>	\$300.00	Fee is \$25.00 per credit hour. Students may opt out of this fee only through Follett Bookstore.

<b>20 for 20</b>	\$15.00	This fee supports the 20 for 20 Scholarship fund supporting students with unmet financial needs.
<b>AROTC</b>	\$2.00	This fee supports Southern University's Army Reserve Officer Training Corp, the Jaguar Battalion.
<b>Career Services</b>	\$5.00	The Career Fee is for the purpose to fund various career workshops, career fairs and networking events for students and alumni, campus recruiting programs.
<b>Carrier</b>	\$15.00	The Carrier Fee was designed for the specific purpose of providing transportation to all students of the University. This fee supports the university's contract with Capital Area Transit Service.
<b>Cheerleader</b>	\$2.00	This fee will be used to cover a variety of expenses encountered by the cheer team.
<b>Gold'N'Bluez Dance Team</b>	\$2.00	The Gold'N'Bluez Fee was created for the specific purpose of supporting the Gold'N'Bluez Dance Team
<b>Gospel Choir</b>	\$1.00	This fee supports the Southern University Gospel Choir (SUGC), a nationally-recognized campus organization founded in 1969.
<b>Health</b>	\$150.00	All students charged the health fee are eligible to see providers in the campus clinic and receive all formulary medications.
<b>Human Jukebox</b>	\$55.00	This fee supports the Southern University Marching Band, known as the Human Jukebox, recognized as one of the nation's top collegiate bands.
<b>Intramural Complex</b>	\$45.00	This fee supports the Horace W. Moody Intramural Sports Complex, providing both organized and informal sports programs.
<b>Intramural Sports</b>	\$2.50	This fee supports intramural sports programs at Southern University.
<b>Jaguar Ambassadors</b>	\$2.00	This fee supports the Jaguar Ambassadors, active and qualified students with a strong desire to represent Southern University.
<b>Jaguar Lanes</b>	\$9.00	This fee supports Jaguar Lanes, a 12-lane bowling alley located in the Smith—Brown Memorial Union.
<b>Lyceum</b>	\$3.00	This fee supports Southern University's Office of Student Programs' Lyceum Speaker Series.
<b>Men and Women Federation</b>	\$7.00	The Men Federation Fee was created for the specific purpose of supporting the Men Federation and The Women Federation Student Fee was created for the specific purpose of supporting the Women's Federation
<b>Royal Court</b>	\$9.00	This fee supports the Royal Court, led by Miss Southern University. He or she serves as a face of the university.
<b>Special Events</b>	\$80.00	This fee supports special events.

<b>Student Facilities Extension</b>	\$5.00	The Facilities Extension Fee was created for the specific purpose of supporting the operation, staffing and maintenance of the Student Union.
<b>Student Government Association</b>	\$12.00	This fee supports the Student Government Association (SGA), an organization that specializes in student advocacy, initiatives, and participation.
<b>Student Identification</b>	\$15.00	This fee supports mandatory student identification cards.
<b>Student Life Improvement</b>	\$2.00	This fee supports initiatives that enhance student life.
<b>Student Media</b>	\$20.00	This fee supports the Office of Student Media, including The Southern Digest (the student newspaper), The Southern Digest, EGO Magazine, and the Jaguar Yearbook.
<b>Student Organization Support</b>	\$8.00	This fee supports student organizations in order to complement and enhance the student experience beyond the classroom.
<b>Student Programs</b>	\$3.00	This fee supports the Student Programming unit with an aim to ensure the holistic development of students during their matriculation
<b>Student Union</b>	\$45.00	The Student Union Fee was created for the specific purpose of supporting the operation, staffing and maintenance of the Student Union
<b>New Student Union</b>	\$72.50	This fee supports the Construction of a new Student Union.
