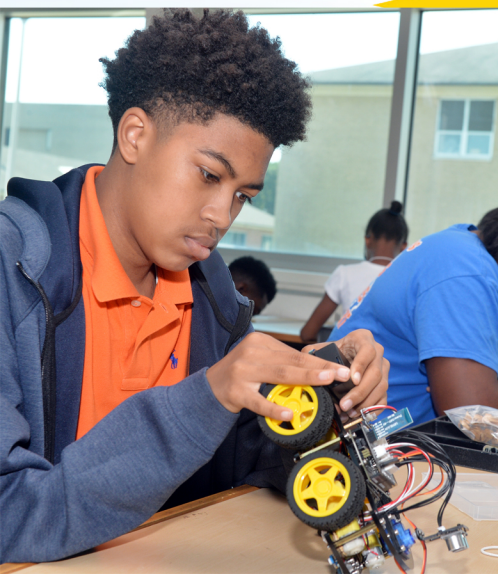

what is CLIMATE?

Cultivating Leadership Innovation by Motivating Agricultural Talents through Education (CLIMATE) is a two year summer program designed specifically for current high school juniors. The overall goal of CLIMATE is to provide supplemental instruction and assist participants in qualifying for the Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) award. Also, to provide participants the opportunity to gain pre-collegiate work experience in a professional internship in their home town or a neighboring parish.

PHASES:

1

PHASE 1 Students will spend four (4) weeks on the Southern University Baton Rouge campus. Participants will attend classes; (English, Math, Sciences and Leadership Development) prepares for the ACT test, and participate in educational short courses and field trips.

2

PHASE 2 As a continuation of Phase 1, students will further their knowledge by working for eight (8) weeks in areas of interests related to agriculture. Participants will be assigned to an internship with either state or local government agencies or community organizations.

what is YOUR commitment?

As a participant of CLIMATE, we ask that you dedicate two (2) summers for this program.

- Phase 1** students will be awarded an educational assistance award of \$500.00 for successful completion of the resident program.
- Phase 2** the returning participants will receive a stipend in the amount of \$2,000.00 for successfully completing the internship.

how much will this COST my family?

Participation in CLIMATE is free of charge; however, students will be responsible for their transportation to and from the Southern University Baton Rouge campus. Additionally, all program related expenses will be covered by the project.

what are the **REQUIREMENTS** for participation?

Only high school juniors are eligible to apply for admission to CLIMATE.

Applicants **MUST** have:

- 2.5 Cumulative Grade Point Average**
- Scored 14-19 on ACT** (**students submitting SAT scored will be correlated to the ACT equivalent score.)

Description: The Engineering Summer Institute (ESI) at Southern University seeks to expose students to career opportunities in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) through its four-week summer program. ESI is a longstanding summer program designed to create an awareness of opportunities which exist in engineering science – particularly civil, electrical and mechanical engineering - and to stimulate an interest more generally in STEM. The goal of ESI is to broaden the access of students to STEM careers by exposing the participants to available options in an environment that facilitates intellectual exchange, academic enrichment, and fosters the learning, sharing, and growing processes. The institute consists of two programs: academic and enhancement. The academic program introduces participants to engineering issues. The curriculum includes problem-based learning projects, use of critical thinking skills, and hands-on projects. The enhancement program covers time management, study habits, test-taking skills, oral and written communication skills, and computer skills. Weekly fieldtrips are taken to enforce what is learned in the classroom. The participants will be engaged in a four-week intensive STEM program.

Criteria:

1. Interest in STEM
2. Upcoming 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th Grader
3. Minimum 2.5 GPA (include an official high school transcript)
4. Two (2) Recommendation forms from current Math and Science Teacher
5. Copy of Standardized Test scores (LEAP, End of Course, PSAT, ACT)
6. A 250 Word essay focused on “How Do I Plan to Impact STEM in the Future”
7. 4-week commitment to ESI (student-parent- institute contract)
8. **\$350 Non-Refundable Registration**



Cost: \$50 non-refundable deposit per student due at Time of Registration, must be postmarked no later than May 15, 2019.
\$300 non-refundable Balance due by May 17, 2019.

What happens at Summer Camp?

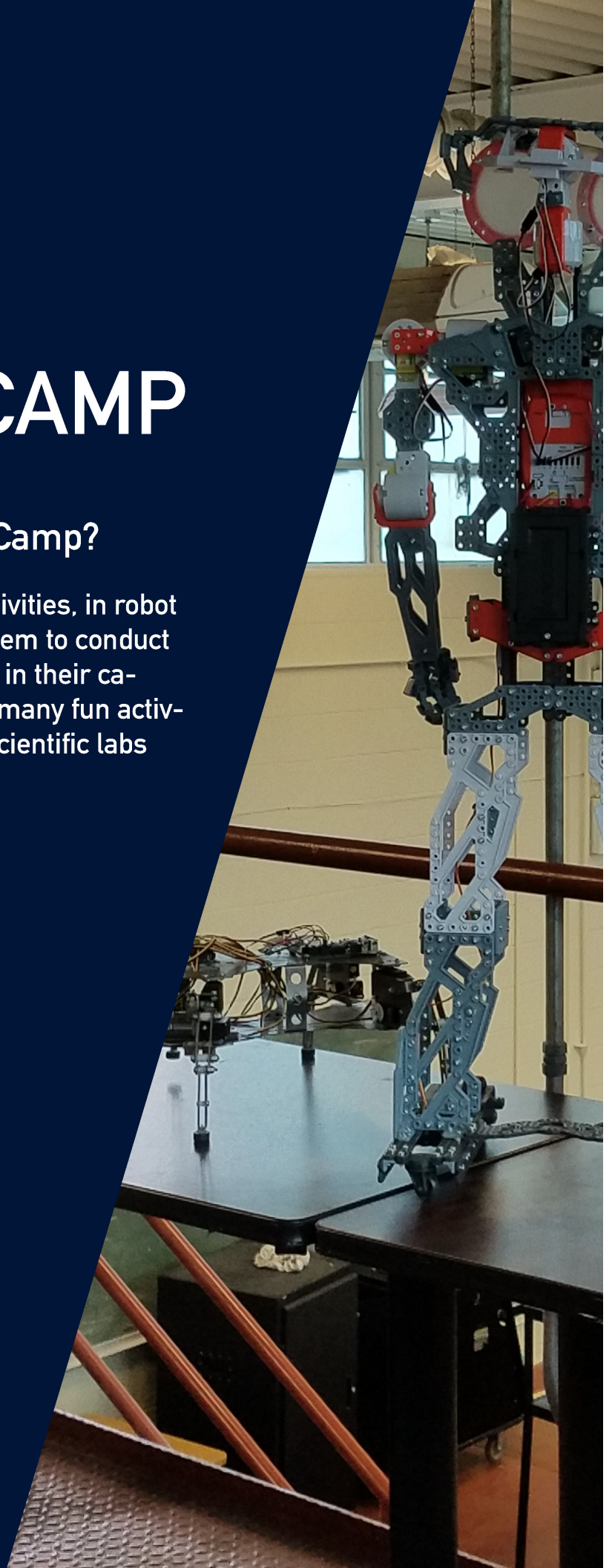
