LOUISIANA RESIDENT

Requirements:

To be fully admitted, first-time freshmen who are graduates of a state-approved high school must meet the following:

2.0 overall GPA (4.0 Scale)

ACT SCORES	18 English	OR	19 Math	20 Composite

OUT OF STATE / HOME SCHOOL

Requirements:

Students who do not meet the Louisiana Core 4 requirements must meet the following:

2.0 overall GPA (4.0 Scale)

ACT SCORES	18 English	OR	19 Math	AND 23 Composite

SAT SCORES	500 Evidence-Based Reading & Writing	OR	510 Math	AND 1130 Composite

AND

LOUISIANA CORE 4

*First-time freshman from a home school program or with General Equivalency Diploma (GED) must have ACT/SAT Composite of 23/1130.

*Home school programs must be state-approved

TRANSFER STUDENTS:

2.0 overall GPA (4.0 Scale)

ENGLISH	C OR BETTER
MATH	C OR BETTER

Have a minimum cumulative college level GPA of 2.0 and have completed a college-level English and a college-level Mathematics course with a grade of "C" or better from a regionally accredited institution.

- These course must fulfill the general education requirements.
- Be eligible to return to the institution from which they are transferring.
- Submit an official transcript(s) from all the universities/ colleges that have been attended
- Submit a copy of their immunization record.

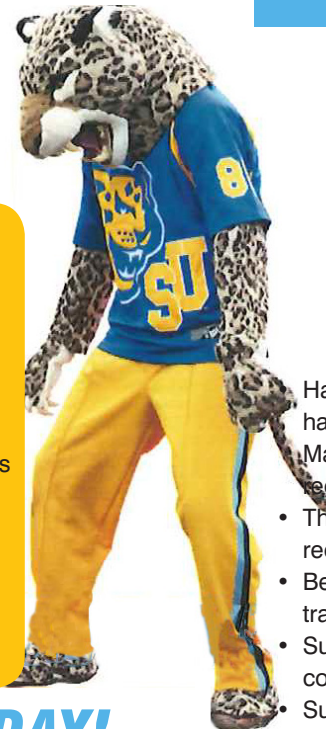

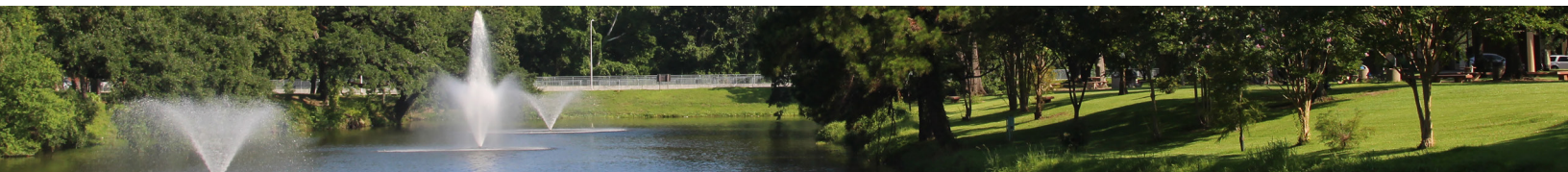
