## *Chancellor's Academic Apprenticeship Program*

*The Chancellor's Academic Apprenticeship Program (C.A.A.P) program is designed to develop a cadre of scholars who are not only high academic achievers but also exceptional leaders and well-trained Food and Agricultural Sciences professionals. Each participant will work closely with a senior faculty mentor and be provided opportunities to conduct or assist with conducting and presenting research, co-author publications and participate in internships and other professional and leadership development experiences.*

### **Chancellor's Academic Apprenticeship Award**

*Upon selection, C.A.A.P participants will be awarded the Chancellor's Academic Apprenticeship Award which provides financial support to students in the form of paid assistantships. Additionally, financial assistance will be provided for participation costs of professional and leadership development events and activities. Awards will be distributed annually (up to four years) until graduation, contingent upon satisfactory completion of academic and program requirements.*

- *Minimum 3.3 Cumulative GPA*
