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## **Graduating Students Survey: Summer 2019**

### **Executive Summary**

The *Graduating Students Survey* provides important information about graduates' evaluation of Southern University at Baton Rouge (SUBR) programs and their plans following graduation. Results of the survey reported below represent valid responses to series of items related to demographics, plans following graduation, additional education plans, educational experiences at SUBR and general satisfaction with the environment and services (Academic Services, Administrative Services and Student Affairs).

### **Demographics**

For the Summer 2019 school year, 72 graduates of Southern University at Baton Rouge participated in *Graduating Students Survey*. The following demographic highlights provide a snapshot of SUBR graduates. Further details are available in Table 1.

#### **Demographic Highlights**

- 67.1% were undergraduate students and 32.9% were graduate students
- 66.7% were female and 33.3% were male
- 91.7% identifies themselves as Black
- 91.2% indicated they were US citizens
- 87.1% indicated they were residents of Louisiana
- 68.1% of the undergraduates were age 25 or under
- 63.0% of undergraduate originally enrolled at SUBR
- 100.0% of the graduate students received their baccalaureate degree from SUBR
- 8.7% of undergraduates attended SUBR for more than 6 years
- 39.1% of undergraduate students and 26.1% of graduate students were active in Student Organizations
- 71.4% worked more than 20 hours per week
- 72.1% did not engage in co-op or internships (70.5% undergraduate; 72.7% graduate)

### **Plans Following Graduation**

Many Southern University graduates have obtained a job prior to graduation. While 30.6% will continue working in jobs held before graduation, 16.7% will work jobs recently obtained. Additionally, 15.3% indicated they would continue their education before working. The graduates tend to pursue opportunities that are directly related to their major course of study (45.9%) and that are within the state of Louisiana (82.8%).

#### **Plans of Undergraduates**

- 14.9% had obtained job prior to graduation
- 27.7% were seeking employment at the time of graduation
- 21.3% planned to continue their education before working
- 35.0% had obtained or were seeking a job that is directly related to their major
- 79.5% had obtained or were seeking a job that is in Louisiana
- 83.0% planned to seek advanced degrees in the future
  - 61.4% Master's Degree
  - 27.3% Doctoral Degree
  - 11.8% at SUBR; 23.5% Out-of-State; 17.6% at LSU-BR

### Plans of Graduate Students

- 21.7% had obtained a job prior to graduation
- 21.7% were seeking employment at the time of graduation
- 4.3% planned to continue their education before working
- 68.4% had obtained or were seeking a job that is directly related to their major
- 88.9% had obtained or were seeking a job that is in Louisiana
- 59.1% planned to seek advanced degrees in the future
  - 72.2% Doctoral Degree
  - 12.5% at SUBR; 50.0% Out-of-State; 0.0% at LSU-BR

### Career Services

- 77.8% of the graduates indicated they did not use Career Services (78.7% undergraduates; 78.3% graduate students)
- 93.3% indicated Career Services did not help them obtain their job
- 36.4% offered neutral feelings concerning their satisfaction with Career Service; 22.7% were satisfied; 27.3% very satisfied
- 39.2% indicated the reason they did not use Career Services was that they already had jobs
- 23.5% listed “Other” as the reason they did not use Career Services
- 13.7% indicated they did not know about Career Services
