Duration: Renewable each year, for four (4) years, based on academic performance while pursing undergraduate degree.

Description: The Louis Stokes-Louisiana Alliance for Minority Participation (LS-LAMP) Program is a mentoring and scholarship

program that is designed to substantially increase the quantity and quality of minority students receiving baccalaureate degrees in science, technology, and mathematics disciplines and subsequently to increase the number of minority students entering graduate school to earn doctorate degrees in the above fields. Participation in research (academic year and summer) and weekly seminar attendance are some essential conditions for continued support. LS- LAMP is funded by the National

Science Foundation (NSF) and the Louisiana Board of Regents (BOR).

Criteria: Scholarship eligibility criteria include (a) a minimum GPA of 2.80/4.00 (overall and in the major); (b) at least a 20 ACT

composite score or a 1410 SAT (940 Old SAT) composite score (for incoming freshmen); (c) grades in mathematics and sciences courses; (d) intention to pursue full-time (minimum of 15 hours/semester) undergraduate studies at SUBR leading to a baccalaureate degrees in a science, technology, and mathematics discipline, not to lead to the practice of medicine; (e) intentions to pursue graduate studies (preferably leading to the Ph.D. degree) in the specified areas (not to include the practice of medicine) after obtaining the baccalaureate degree; (f) need, as verified by Financial Aid. Students are evaluated each

semester for retention and continuation of scholarship status; and (g) United States citizenship.

Cost: Enrollment fees (i.e., tuition, room/board, and fees).
