

CAPTAIN WILBERT RÈMONTÈ BYNUM, SC, USN

Captain Bynum hails from Tupelo, MS and was commissioned through the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps (NROTC) Program at Southern University, Baton Rouge, LA, earning a bachelor's degree in Mathematics with a minor in Physics in 1989. He later earned a Master's Degree in Management at Troy University and completed Executive Training at the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.

Captain Bynum has served in a variety of sea and shore duty assignments prior to assuming his current position. At sea, his assignments have included: Supply Officer, USS GEORGE H. W. BUSH (CVN 77); Assistant Supply Officer, USS NIMITZ (CVN 68); Supply Officer, USS FLATLEY (FFG 21); and Disbursing and Sales Officer, USS MARVIN SHIELDS (FF 1066).

Captain Bynum was the commissioning Supply Officer in USS GEORGE H. W. BUSH (CVN 77) where he was responsible for creating logistics, inventory and quality of life operations for 17 departments, supporting over 70 aircraft and 4,500 personnel.

Captain Bynum's previous ashore assignments include: Director of Logistics, Combined, Joint Task Force – Horn of Africa; Assistant DCOS for Logistics, Fleet Supply & Ordnance, Commander, U.S. Pacific Fleet; Deputy Force Supply Officer, Commander, U.S. Naval Air Forces; Deputy Logistics Branch Head, Commander, Naval Supply Systems Command; F/A-18E/F Integrated Weapons System Team Lead, Naval Inventory Control Point, Philadelphia; Assistant Chief of Staff for Logistics, Commander, U.S. Naval Forces, Marianas; and Assistant Supply Officer, Naval Support Activity, New Orleans.

While on Guam, CAPT Bynum concurrently served as Materiel and Freight Terminal Officer, Fleet and Industrial Supply Center (FISC), Guam; Supply Officer, Naval Support Activity, Guam; and J4 Logistics Action Officer, Joint Task Force - Operation Pacific Haven, Andersen, AFB.

A Joint Qualified Officer and member of the Navy Acquisition Community, Captain Bynum is dual warfare qualified as a Naval Aviation Supply Officer and a Surface Warfare Supply Corps Officer.

Captain Bynum's personal decorations include the Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (three awards), Joint Service Commendation Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (four awards) and Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal.
