Evaluation and treatment sessions are provided by students enrolled in either the graduate program in Speech-Language Pathology or the undergraduate program in Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology. Students are supervised by clinical faculty who are professional speech-language pathologists and hold a full state license by the Louisiana Board of Examiners for Speech Pathology and Audiology and the Certificate of Clinical Competence by the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (www.asha.org).

SPECIALIZED EVALUATIONS FOR CHILDREN

1. Screenings of articulation, fluency, voice, hearing, language, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication and augmentative and alternative communication modality needs.
2. Individualized evaluations and treatment for delays in articulation, fluency, voice, language, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication and augmentative and alternative communication modality needs.
3. Parent/caregiver training.

SPECIALIZED EVALUATIONS FOR ADULTS

Adult therapy is provided for deficits in articulation, fluency, voice, language, swallowing, cognitive aspects of communication, social aspects of communication and augmentative and alternative communication modality needs. Example areas include post-stroke rehabilitation, brain injury, voice, stuttering, accent reduction, swallowing disorders and speech production.
