Presidents Legacy Scholarship

Any student who wishes to continue receiving the out-of-state fee scholarship beyond the initial academic year in which the Scholarship is awarded, must:

- Retain a full-time status with a minimum of 12 hours (non-developmental) course load per semester
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Scores have to be met on the same test
