## Admissions for First-Time First-Year Louisiana Residents

4	Mathematics: Algebra 1A and Algebra 1B, Geometry, Algebra II, Financial Math, Math Essentials, Advanced Pre-Calculus, Advanced Functions & Statistics, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Probability and Statistics, Discrete Math, MMOD, Approved Elective (including approved IBC related course)
4	Natural Science: Biology, Chemistry, two (2) units from: Physical Science, Integrated Science, Physics I, Physics of Technology I, Aerospace Science, Biology II, Chemistry II, Earth Science, Environmental science, Physics II, Physics of Technology II, Agriscience I, Agriscience II, Anatomy and Physiology, Forensic Science, Astronomy, Aquatic Science, Marine Science, Zoology
4	Social Science: Civics, AP American Government Plus Free enterprise (1/2) unit each), U.S. History, World History, World Geography, Human Geography, Cultural Geography, Western Civilization, AP European History, Law Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Civics (2 <sup>nd</sup> Semester, ½ Unit), African American Studies, State History, Theology
2	Foreign Language/Speech: Two (2) units from single language or 2 units of Speech
1	Arts: Fine Arts Survey , Drama, Art, Dance, Performing Arts, Theatre, Applied Arts, Band, Chorus

- Minimum Overall Cumulative High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

# And One of the following:

- 2.0 Core GPA or higher
- Associate Degree/ 9 Early College Academic Credit Hours w/ 2.0
- ACT Composite 20 / SAT Composite of 1030

First-Time First-Year students who graduate from an Out-of-State High School must meet one the following Minimum Admissions Criteria:

### Criteria 1 (Out-of-State)

- Completion of Louisiana Board of Regents' High School Core Curriculum (Must have ALL 19 Core Units)
- Minimum Overall Cumulative High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

#### And One of the following:

- 2.0 Core GPA or higher
- Associate Degree/ 9 Early College Academic Credit Hours w/ 2.0
- ACT Composite 20 / SAT Composite of 1030

## Criteria 2 (Out-of-State)

- Completion of Louisiana Board of Regents' High School Core Curriculum (Must have 17 or 18 Core Units)
- Minimum Overall Cumulative High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

#### And One of the following:

- 2.5 Core GPA or higher
- ACT Composite 23 / SAT Composite 1030
- Institution Early College Requirement w/ 2.25 GPA or higher
- Two of the following: 2.0 Core GPA; Associate Degree/ 9 Early College Academic Credit Hours w/ 2.0; ACT Composite 20 / SAT Composite of 1030

#### Criteria 3 (Out-of-State)

- Completion of Louisiana Board of Regents' High School Core Curriculum (Fewer than 17 Core Units)
- Minimum Overall Cumulative High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

#### And One of the following:

- 2.5 Core GPA or higher
- ACT Composite 23 / SAT Composite 1030
- Institution Early College Requirement w/ 2.25 GPA or higher

#### And One of the following:

• 2.0 Core GPA or higher

- Associate Degree/ 9 Early College Academic Credit Hours w/ 2.0
- ACT Composite 20 / SAT Composite of 1030

# **Criteria 4 (GED Students)**

- HiSET: 15 on any subtest AND 4 on HiSET Essay OR
- NRS: Score level 6 on NRS Approved Assessment AND
- Minimum ACT Composite Score of 20 / SAT Composite Score 1030
