



FAQ's

1. What is the Accuplacer test?
Accuplacer is a placement test SUBR uses to determine course placement and to set students up for success. SUBR offers the Next-Generation Accuplacer.
2. How many times can I take the Accuplacer test?
Students are allowed **One** attempt per registration period.
3. What are the scores accepted by SUBR for college level courses?
QRAS Math 250
English 250
4. What is the fee for Accuplacer test?
The cost is **\$25 per testing session (Non Refundable)**
5. How to prepare for the Accuplacer Test?

6. Who can I contact to register or for additional testing information?

7. Is the Accuplacer test timed?
No, you are not timed however, the average test timing is 2.5 hours.
8. What is needed to take Accuplacer via Online /Remote Proctoring Option?
You will need a desktop, laptop, or Chromebook with a web camera, you will need internet access, a quiet location in which to take the test, and photo id to prove your identity.
9. What is needed to take Accuplacer via In Person Proctoring Option?
Ability to come on campus SUBR – Baton Rouge Campus and photo id to prove your identity.
10. How will the Office of Admission know my score?
Admission will receive scores for students automatically via Accuplacer Score Report Platform.

Accuplacer Testing for Incoming SUBR/Dual Enrollment Students:

Incoming SUBR or Dual Enrollment students **without an ACT or SAT score** must contact the **Center for Student Success** to receive approval for Accuplacer testing and registration.

Registration Procedures:

1. **Email** the Coordinator for Student Success at **Vernestine.Jiles@sus.edu** or call **225-771-4345** to request testing approval.
2. Allow **48 hours for processing** once your request is submitted.
3. Upon approval, you will receive a **Testing Voucher**, which is valid for **90 days**.
4. A staff member will **confirm your official testing date** and provide further instructions.
