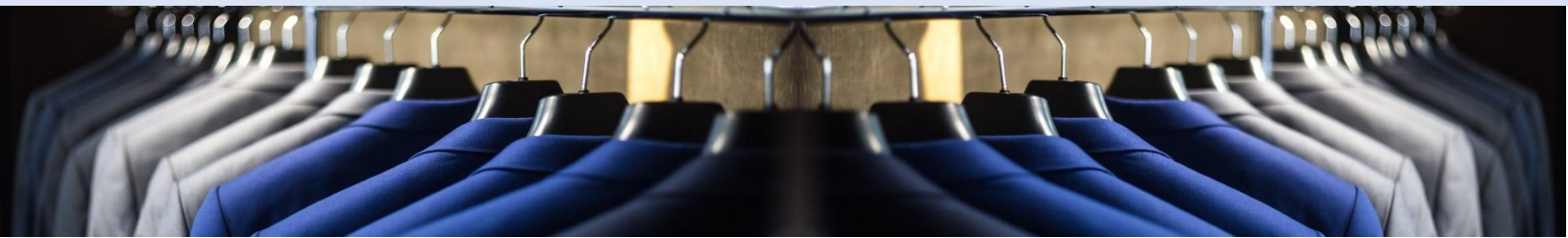

What is the Career Clothes Closet Program?

We will provide students with “new or gently used” clothing donated by alumni, business professionals, faculty, staff, students, and other professional organizations. Students are not required to return the clothing; it is for keeps for the benefit of their future.

Required Items:

- Current SUBR ID and Hardship Application (attached)
- Bring an updated resume for review and critiquing by one of the Career Services Center staff.
- Handshake information profile complete with professional photo and resume upload
- Attend two information sessions or two events sponsored by the Career Services Center or other academic units.
