



## Undergraduate Academic Appeal Process

If an **undergraduate** student's Academic Standing is Suspension at the end of the Spring term:

1. The student will be permitted to enroll in courses for the Summer term to improve his or her cumulative G.P.A.
2. If the student does not earn a 1.51 cumulative GPA, the student will be required to sit out at least one semester. An undergraduate student who have been absent for one semester while on academic suspension, may be permitted to return to the University without submitting an academic appeal. Upon return, the student's academic status will be changed to academic probation. As a condition of re-enrollment, students must also sign an ***Academic Agreement Acknowledgement Statement*** adhering to the terms of their return ***and the Jaguar Academic Reset Plan***.
3. If the student decides not to attend Summer school, the student can submit an Academic Appeal for the Fall term. The student will be required to submit all supporting documentation.
  - a. If the appeal is **approved**, the student will be able to return for the Fall semester and will be required to complete the ***Academic Agreement Acknowledgment Statement and the Jaguar Academic Reset Plan***.
  - b. If the appeal is **denied**, the student will not be able to return for the Fall term; however, the student will be allowed to return for the following Spring term and will NOT have to submit another Academic Appeal.
