This theme gives voice to the impact the many facets of public works have on modern civilization, honors the vital contribution public works professionals make every day to communities all across North America, and invites the public to celebrate these professionals’ quiet dedication and indispensable influence on our way of life. Your essay should demonstrate your understanding about the importance of public works in your daily life. Chosen winners will be required to attend the Metro Council Meeting on May 23, 2018, or a later Council meeting, where the scholarships will be presented.
