COMPLETE THE FAFSA APPLICATION

Complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA Application at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>

CHECK VERIFICATION STATUS

Students will be notified via email by The Office of Student Financial Aid if they have been randomly selected for verification by the Department of Education. SUBR cannot award financial aid until verification has been completed.

To check for missing documents students can log into Banner Self Service, click on Financial Aid tab, then click on **Financial Aid Eligibility** and,/**Financial Aid Status**.

VIEW YOUR FINANCIAL AID OFFER

A second email will be sent to your SUS email address regarding your estimated aid offer.

ACCEPT/DECLINE AID OFFER

In order to view, accept, or decline your financial aid offer you must log in to your Banner Self Service Account; select the Financial Aid tab, choose Award, and select the appropriate aid year from the drop-down menu.

Select the "Resources/Additional Information" tab; then select the "Terms and Conditions" tab first, read the terms and conditions for Financial Aid and Click Accept at the bottom of page.

Select the Award Offer tab to accept or decline your aid offers.

Fall Semester: July 31

DIRECT STUDENT LOAN DEADLINES

November 15, 2024 -Deadline to apply for a Federal Student Loan for Fall 24 semester only.

April 25, 2025 - Deadline to apply for a Federal Student Loan for both the Fall 24 and Spring 25 semesters or a Spring only semester loan.

July 1, 2025- Deadline to apply for a federal student loan for Summer 25.
