## Audition Requirements

## Wind Instruments

All twelve (12) major scales must be memorized and played two (2) or more octaves when necessary

Students must be able to play the full range of instrument for the grand chromatic scale

Grand Chromatic Scale

- <u>Flute</u> C4 (C below staff) to C 7
- <u>Clarinet</u> F3 (F below the staff) to F6 (F above the staff)
- <u>Alto Saxophone</u> Bb 3 (below the staff) to C6 (C above the Staff)
- <u>Tenor Saxophone</u> Bb 3 (below the staff) to C6 (C above the Staff)
- <u>Trumpet F sharp below the staff to C6 above the staff</u>
- <u>Mellophone</u> F sharp below the staff to C6 above the staff
- <u>French horn</u> B flat below the staff to C6 above the staff
- <u>Baritone</u> F below staff to B flat 4 (ledger line B flat)
- <u>Baritone T.C.</u> G below staff to C6 (ledger line C)
- <u>Trombone</u> F below staff to B flat 4 (ledger line B flat)
- <u>Tuba</u> low Bb to Bb 3 (Bb above the staff)

All scales should tongued ascending and slurred descending.

A prepared classical (solo or etude) is required as well.

The last part of the audition consists of sight-reading.

## Percussion

- Memorize and perform the twenty-six (26) essential drum rudiments
- Prepared snare drum solo
- Sight reading of snare drum literature
