100% Online RN to BSN Program

Southern University A&M offers a 100% online RN to BSN program. With the flexibility of online coursework, working nurses can balance their career, family and other responsibilities while advancing their education.

If you graduated from a nationally accredited Associate Degree Nursing (ADN) program as a Registered Nurse (RN), you may be eligible to enroll in the online RN to BSN program. Affiliation Agreements were developed to support educational mobility and facilitate the seamless transfer of academic credit between associate degree (ADN) programs and Southern University's Baccalaureate (BSN) Nursing program.

Our instructors have real-world nursing experience and are experts in teaching and training nurses through the online modality. They offer support and guidance to ensure the highest quality education.

The Baccalaureate degree program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).

Admissions Criteria

- Have earned an associate degree from an ACEN or CCNE accredited nursing program
- Hold an active, unencumbered registered nurse license

Curriculum Requirements

- Earn a "C" or better in all required Associate Degree nursing and non-nursing courses.
- Thirty-six (36) credit hours of required prerequisite courses must be completed before enrolling in the RN to BSN Nursing program.
- Twenty-two (22) credit hours of required courses must be completed to earn the BSN. These courses can be:
 - transferred from a regionally accredited institution,
 - completed at Southern University before enrollment in the RN to BSN Nursing program, or
 - completed at Southern University during enrollment in the RN to BSN Nursing program
- Thirty-four (24) credit hours of RN to BSN Nursing courses must be completed at Southern University to earn the BSN.

- Select **Admissions Term**
- Complete **all sections** of the **Application Checklist**.

Frequently Asked Questions

100% Online RN to BSN Program

Is Southern University's 100% online RN to BSN Program accredited?

- The baccalaureate degree program in nursing at Southern University A&M College is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE), 655 K Street, NW, Suite 750, Washington, DC 20001, 202-8876791.

Is the program available in a face-to-face setting?

- No. Conveniently 100% online, nursing professionals have the flexibility to work while completing their BSN.

How long does it take to complete the SUBR RN to BSN Online Program?

- 1 year or five 8-week sessions.

Can I take all prerequisite courses then apply?

- Yes. General prerequisites are required as listed on the plan of study.

What if I did not take the courses listed in RN to BSN Program curriculum? Can I take the courses while enrolled in nursing courses?

- Yes. The RN to BSN curriculum was designed to accommodate additional courses, if needed.

How long is each course?

- Each course is 8 weeks. There are two 8-week sessions per semester.

How much does it cost to complete the 100% Online RN to BSN Program?

- When scheduling nursing courses only, this cost-effective program will cost approximately \$10,000. If you plan on following the curriculum with non-nursing courses, expect that number to increase.

Does my nursing license have to be from the state of Louisiana?

- No. RN licenses are accepted from your primary state of practice. If you graduated from a nationally accredited associate degree nursing program as a Registered Nurse (RN), you are eligible to complete the 100% online RN to BSN program.
