Prior to enrolling in any Advanced Clinical Practicum, students must complete a minimum of twenty-five documented clinical observation hours. In addition, a grade of "B" or better must be achieved in a disorder area and verification of standards having been met in each of the following courses: SECD 528, 530, 555, 558, 559, 560, 583, 584 and 667 prior to enrolling in a related clinic.

SECD 558, is a prerequisite to SECD 555, 559, 599-03, and 667 and must be completed with a grade of "B" or better.

***This is the recommended sequence and may require modification based on individual student needs. For the first summer term only SECD 567, 568, 569, 571, students may register for 1 credit hour for up to a maximum of 3 credit hours based on individual student needs. Meeting with the Graduate Program Director and Clinical Coordinator is required for all clinic registration every semester.
