Campus Step Show Rules and Regulations (Related to NPHC Organizations)

Springfest Rules

General

- 1. Admission to this Springfest Activity will be ten dollars (\$10.00) at the door to the general public; to include members of Greek organizations.
- 2. Each organization <u>must</u> submit a list of members participating in the show by A SPECIFIED DATE. With a maximum of twelve (12) members and two (2) prop persons. <u>The finalized list of members participating must be certified by the chapter advisor</u>.
- 3. Members of the step teams <u>must</u> be full-time enrolled students at Southern University and A&M College.
- 4. **No** Fraternity Sweethearts or Sorority Sweetheart/beau will be allowed to enter free of charge.
- 5. Members of the National Pan Hellenic Council (NPHC) will governed by the Standards of Greek Life Code of Conduct, the Constitution of the NPHC, and the University Student Code of Conduct.
- 6. <u>Greek show participants who are on the step teams must present valid student ID at the door to enter (Service Entrance of the F. G. Clark Activity Center).</u>

Participation

- 1. Any active Greek organization represented by the Southern University NPHC is eligible to participate in the Springfest Greek Show.
- 2. Each participating organization must be in **good standing** with the NPHC and the University (i.e. no suspended or expelled organization will be allowed to participate!)

Rules of Governance and Procedures

- 1. Each organization shall have a maximum of ten (10) minutes to perform. The time limit <u>will include</u> entrance and departure from the stage!
- 2. The show/routine can consist of steps, stomps, marches, chants songs, segways or any innovative movements that are <u>not</u> a vulgar nature or suggest any vulgarity. No Greek bashing allowed in shows.
- 3. Vulgar or obscene language or gestures <u>will not</u> be permitted or tolerated in this activity. Non-adherence is grounds for <u>disqualification and halting of performance</u>!
- 4. Every effort must be made by performing organizations to be present and **on time** for all aspects of the Greek Show. Tardiness may lead to loss of points or disqualification.

Homecoming Rules

General

- 1. Admission to this Homecoming Activity will be ten dollars (\$10.00) pre-sale and ten dollars (\$10.00) at the door to the general public; to include members of Greek organizations.
- 2. Each organization <u>must</u> submit a list of members participating in the show by A SPECIFIED DATE. With a maximum of twelve (12) members and two (2) prop persons. <u>The finalized list of members participating must be certified by the chapter advisor</u>.
- Members of the step teams <u>must</u> be full-time enrolled students at Southern University and A&M College.
- 4. **No** Fraternity Sweethearts or Sorority Sweetheart/beau will be allowed to enter free of charge.

- 5. Members of the National Pan Hellenic Council (NPHC) will governed by the Standards of Greek Life Code of Conduct, the Constitution of the NPHC, and the University Student Code of Conduct.
- 6. All decisions rendered by the adjudication will be final!
- 7. <u>Greek show participants who are on the step teams must present valid student ID at the door to enter (Service Entrance of the F. G. Clark Activity Center).</u>
- 8. Cash prizes are as follows:

Participation

- 1. Any active Greek organization represented by the Southern University NPHC is eligible to participate in the Homecoming Greek Extravaganza.
- 2. Each participating organization must be in **good standing** with the NPHC and the University (i.e. no suspended or expelled organization will be allowed to participate!)

Rules of Governance and Procedures

- 1. Each organization shall have a maximum of ten (10) minutes to perform. The time limit <u>will</u> <u>include</u> entrance and departure from the stage!
- 2. The show/routine can consist of steps, stomps, marches, chants songs, segways or any innovative movements that are <u>not</u> a vulgar nature or suggest any vulgarity. No Greek bashing allowed in shows.
- 3. Vulgar or obscene language or gestures <u>will not</u> be permitted or tolerated in this activity. Non-adherence is grounds for <u>disqualification and halting of performance</u>!
- 4. Every effort must be made by performing organizations to be present and <u>on time</u> for all aspects of the Greek Show. Tardiness may lead to loss of points or disqualification.

Ties

- 1. If there is a tie for 1st place and 4 teams (Two (2) Fraternities/Two (2) Sororities) are able to participate in the Bayou Classic Greek Show, both 1st place will represent Southern University!!! (Prize money for the tied teams will be awarded at Southern University as the teams originally adjudicated!)
- 2. In case of a tie between any two second place teams, the highest and the lowest score will be dropped from the cumulative score of both teams; and the team with the higher score will be the second place winner.
- 3. There also may be a case where the dropping of the high and low score will result in another tie, thus the procedure will be followed.
- 4. In case of a tie between two second place teams, after the highest and the lowest score have been dropped from the cumulative score both teams; a cumulative score of the crowd/audience participation will be calculated and the team with the highest score will be awarded the place in question.
- 5. Lastly, if none of the above methods can break the tie, the teams tied will utilize a "flip of the coin" method.
