

Undergraduate Admission Requirements

Admissions for Beginning Freshmen from Louisiana

4	English: I, II, III, IV
4	Mathematics: Algebra 1A and Algebra 1B, Geometry, Algebra II, Financial Math, Math Essentials, Advanced Pre-Calculus, Advanced Functions & Statistics, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Probability and Statistics, Discrete Math, MMOD, Approved Elective (including approved IBC related course)
4	Natural Science: Biology, Chemistry, two (2) units from: Physical Science, Integrated Science, Physics I, Physics of Technology I, Aerospace Science, Biology II, Chemistry II, Earth Science, Environmental science, Physics II, Physics of Technology II, Agriscience I, Agriscience II, Anatomy and Physiology, Forensic Science, Astronomy, Aquatic Science, Marine Science, Zoology
4	Social Science: Civics, AP American Government plus Free enterprise (1/2) unit each), U.S. History, World History, World Geography, Human Geography, Cultural Geography, Western Civilization, AP European History, Law Studies, Psychology, Sociology, Civics (2 nd Semester, ½ Unit), African American Studies, State History, Theology
2	Foreign Language/Speech: Two (2) units from single language or 2 units of Speech
1	Arts: Fine Arts Survey , Drama, Art, Dance, Performing Arts, Theatre, Applied Arts, Band, Chorus
19	Total Core Curriculum Units

AND Minimum Overall High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

AND Require only one Developmental Course by having a Minimum ACT English Score of 18 **OR** Math Score of 19

OR SAT Evidence-Based Reading/Writing Score of 500 **OR** Math Score of 510

And One of the following: Core GPA of 2.0 **OR** ACT Composite score of 20 **OR** SAT Composite of 1030

Beginning Freshmen (Out-of-State or Home-Schooled)

Freshman students, who graduate from out-of-state schools or home schooled, must meet the following minimum admissions criteria:

Criteria 1

- Completion of Louisiana Board of Regents' High School Core Curriculum;
- Minimum Overall High School GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum ACT English Score of 18 **OR** Math Score of 19
- Minimum SAT Evidence-Based Reading/Writing Score of 500 **OR** Math Score of 510

And One of the following: Core GPA of 2.0 **OR** ACT Composite score of 20 **OR** SAT Composite of 1030

Criteria 2

- Minimum high school GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
- Minimum ACT English Score of 18 **OR** Math Score of 19 **AND** ACT Composite Score of 23
- Minimum SAT Evidence-Based Reading/Writing Score of 500 **OR** Math Score of 510 **AND** SAT Composite Score of 1130.

Admissions for Students with GED

Students who have successfully completed the General Education Development (GED) program must have an ACT composite score of 23 or higher **OR** SAT total score of 1130.

Admissions for International Students

International students for whom English is a second language have two options to satisfy SUBR's English proficiency requirement. They may take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS).

- A minimum score of 500 on the TOEFL or a score of 5 on the IELTS
- High School GPA of 2.5 or better
- Have a Minimum ACT English Score of 18 **AND** ACT Math Score of 19 **OR** SAT Evidence-Based Reading/Writing Score of 500 **AND** SAT Math Score of 510.
