AT A GLANCE

FOUNDED

Southern University was founded in 1880 and chartered as Southern College in New Orleans. In 1890, Southern University was designated as a land grant college for blacks to support higher education for all students in a segregated higher education system, and the Agricultural and Mechanical department was established. In 1914, the university moved to Scotlandville, along Scott's Bluff facing the Mississippi River and north of Baton Rouge.

CAMPUS

The campus is situated on 512 acres, with an agricultural experimental station on an additional 372-acre site, five miles north of the main campus.

ENROLLMENT

Approximately 6700 students representing 44 states and 29 countries.

STUDENT LIFE

More than 80 student clubs and organizations, a wellness and recreation center, bowling alley, and active athletic programs with active alumni engagement.

HUMAN JUKEBOX

The Human Jukebox, which includes the Fabulous Dancing Dolls, is the internationally renowned collegiate marching band that has represented the university since 1947.

STUDENT HOUSING

On-campus housing accommodates 2360 students.

FINANCIAL AID

Approximately 98% of our students receive financial aid, scholarships and grants.

challenged and nurtured through the use of innovative pedagogy, flexible and competitive curricula, and mentoring relationships with distinguished faculty and scholars.

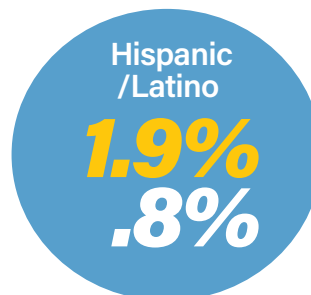
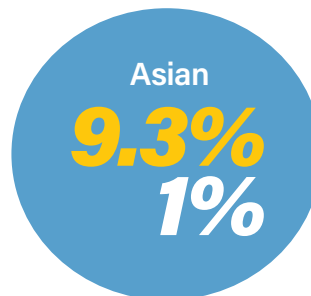
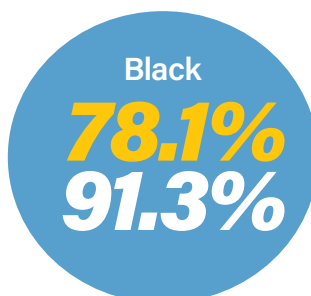
Graduates of the Honors College are sought out for employment by national corporations and admission to graduate and professional schools.

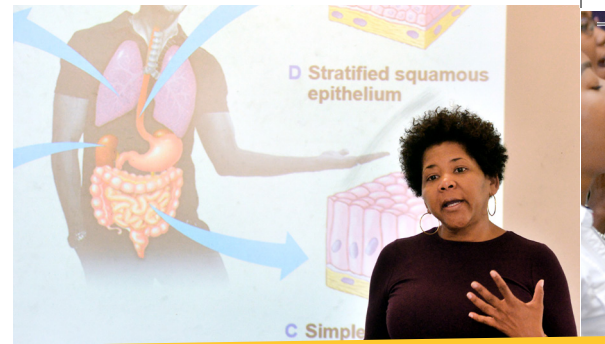

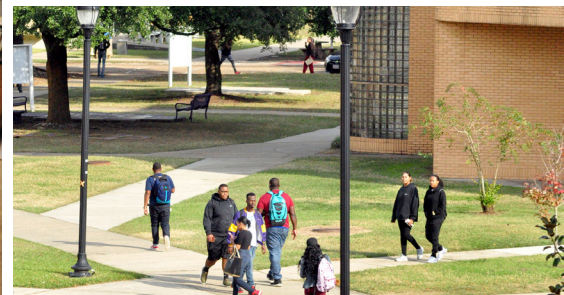
